EPA is hosting two open houses to meet local residents and share information on its investigation of hazardous waste contamination in the Upper Columbia River. The study is called a Remedial Investigation and Feasibility Study (RI/FS). It will evaluate contamination caused by smelters, industrial activities, mining and milling operations, and other sources, and determine whether a cleanup is needed.
